

THE FOUR R'S OF SOLID WASTE

1. **REDUCE:** Buy only what you need and use whatever you buy. Look for items with minimal packaging and with packaging that is recyclable.
2. **REPAIR:** Fix items that are broken rather than buy new ones. If you don't want to fix them, please give them to someone who will.
3. **REUSE:** Look for reusable—rather than disposable—items. If you can no longer use something, give or sell it to someone who can.
4. **RECYCLE:** Create new items out of unwanted ones.

WHY RECYCLE?

Because Recycling...

Reduces the amount of solid waste to the landfill. This saves tax dollars.

Promotes conservation of natural resources.

Reduces pollution and saves energy.

Look for products that state they are recycled. Even better, buy those that have post-consumer recycled contents.



RINDGE TRANSFER STATION RULES

This facility is open to all Rindge residents, non-resident property owners, and businesses.

Users of this facility must obtain a permit sticker from the Selectmen's Office that must be displayed on the passenger's side rear window of the vehicle. Vehicles without stickers will not be permitted to use the facility.

The Town of Rindge implemented Mandatory Recycling on September 1, 1992. All users of this facility must separate and deposit items in the appropriate bins as listed on the other side of this flyer.

Hazardous waste items are not accepted and will be refused. Please save these items for the annual Household Hazardous Waste Day.

The Swap Shop is open Tuesdays and Thursdays 10:00-3:00 and Saturdays 8:00-3:00. Items may be left for the Swap Shop only when it is open.

To post a community activity on the Transfer Station sign, please sign out the letter bin at the Town Office.

Household Waste Rules & Regulations

1. The Transfer Station only accepts clear or transparent tinted bags.

White, black, or colored bags, and tints deemed non-transparent by the Attendant, will not be accepted.

2. The Transfer Station will accept dumping of barrels in the compactor.

The barrel cannot be lined with a plastic bag; rubbish must be loose.

3. The Transfer Station will accept four personal bags of four gallons or less. This includes plastic grocery bags.

4. Wood pellet bags will be accepted individually, bundled or in clear bags.

WHAT TO RECYCLE

PUNCH CARDS



MIX BIN #1

GLASS (any color)

DESCRIPTION

Glass jars and bottles, lids are okay. No plate or window glass mirrors, light bulbs, or ceramics.

HOW TO RECYCLE

Rinse out. No Fee

ALUMINUM, TIN & STEEL CANS

Beverage cans such as beer, soda and juice, dog and cat food cans.

Rinse out. Do not crush No Fee

PLASTIC CONTAINERS (any color)
 (#1 AND #2 PLASTIC ONLY)
NO PLASTIC BAGS

Milk, windshield washer fluid, shampoo, laundry detergent, flower pots. No motor oils/antifreeze.

Rinse out. Labels are okay No Fee
 Okay to flatten milk.



MIX BIN #2

PAPER, CARD STOCK
NO PLASTIC BAGS

DESCRIPTION

All newsprint. All unsoiled food boxes, magazines, glossy inserts, junk mail, shredded paper, cereal, shoe, or detergent boxes.

HOW TO RECYCLE

Keep dry, bag, or bundle..... No Fee



CARDBOARD BIN

DESCRIPTION

Double-walled, corrugated.

HOW TO RECYCLE

Keep dry and clean, flatten out..... No Fee

NO ANTIFREEZE

WET CELL BATTERIES

TIRES

LEAVES & GRASS CLIPPINGS

DEMOLIT'N DEBRIS (no Contractors)

DESCRIPTION

Small items, including white goods.

Up to 50-weight oil (No gasoline).

Anything that will not fit in the compactor

From cars, trucks, boats, etc.

Auto, truck, motorcycle, bicycle

No sticks, twigs, or branches

Clean lumber, sheetrock, etc.

No Antifreeze
