Call to Order

Pledge of Allegiance

Citizen's Forum –Bob Cleland stated that the Conservation commission was looking into making a town wide Arial map that they can hang in the Selectmen's office. This will be at no cost to the Town. They are also working on training for Robyn, Julie, Jane and Bob for the new GIS software.

Approval of Minutes

05-05-10 – Motion made by Barry to accept the minutes of 05-05-10, 2nd by Brummer. All members were in favor.

General Business

Welfare Allowable Levels of Assistance – Mary Drew was present to talk with the Selectmen. Drew stated that she takes her numbers from what the State goes off of. They have already done all the work, so she just goes along with it. The only difference is that she allows for car repairs or car payments. The shelter expenses come directly from HUD. Brummer made a motion to accept the recommendations from the Welfare Director, 2nd by Barry. All members were in favor.

Vehicular Parking Ordinance – Cleland was present and stated that this is a compound of 4-5 ordinances that Chief Sielicki and Evelyn Wilkie have been working. This is in line with the state. Until these are passed, they can not order their new tickets. Motion made by Barry to adopt the updated Town of Rindge Ordinance for Vehicular Parking, 2nd by Brummer. All members were in favor.

Fire works Permit Ordinance – Cleland stated that this is an update to the one that was brought to the Selectmen earlier in the year. The Selectmen had concerns and Chief Sielicki has some additions. Motion made by Brummer to accept the changes to the Town of Rindge Ordinance concerning the Fireworks Permit Ordinance. All members were in favor.

Knights of Columbus – permit to solicit at Market Basket – Pini stated that the last time that the BOS got a request there was a discussion as to whether or not the board needed to sign off on these things. Pini has gotten two ordinances from other towns to look at for the Town of Rindge. It is a broad spectrum and we need more research. Barry made a motion to allow the chairman of the Tootsie Roll Drive to solicit donations at Market Basket on June 12th, 2nd by Brummer. All members were in favor.

Payroll Manifest – Motion made by Barry to accept the Payroll manifest, 2nd by Brummer. All members were in favor.

Accounts Payable Manifest – Motion made by Brummer to accept the Accounts Payable manifest, 2nd by Barry. All members were in favor.

Town Administrator's Report

Ongoing Business –Pini stated that Beth Fernald has been negotiating with all the lenders for the Senior Housing project. They are tinkering with the water agreement and the lease. It appears that they have reached an agreement, but she does not have all the paperwork yet. Jane Pitt went to the pre-construction meeting today and made it well know that the tree lines are to be well maintained and Bob VanDyke will not be allowed to haul through town. SVE will be in town tomorrow flagging trees and start cutting right away.

The Recreation Committee met last night. They bought their bus. Craig was able to get the bus for \$3000, he was authorized to have \$5000. There are a couple of repairs that need to be done and he is looking into painting the bus. The other thing that they are looking into is the letter to editor that Roberta Oeser sent to the paper. There was talk around town that the renaming of the building was a shift in the programs that would be running. The committee would like to write a response to the letter to let the community know that they are not planning on limiting the programs but expanding them. The committee is also looking to work on a Master Plan for the Recreation Department so that we know what direction they are going for.

Non-Public Session per RSA 91-A:3 II. (a) for Personnel – Motion made by Brummer to go into non-public for Personnel, 2nd by Barry. All members were in favor.

Motion made by Brummer to appoint Tom Horne to fulfill a Part-Time Police Officers position, 2nd by Barry. All members were in favor.
